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2.6.2 Attainment of POs and COs are evaluated

CO-PO (Course Outcomes to Programme Outcomes) Attainment serves as a critical measure to assess the effectiveness of educational programs in achieving their defined Course Outcomes (COs) and Programme Outcomes (POs). This evaluation methodology is indispensable for educational institutions to gauge the success of their curricula and teaching methodologies.

Methodology:

CO-PO Attainment is evaluated through a comprehensive range of assessment tools, including examinations (mid-term, final, quizzes), assignments and projects, oral presentations, practical lab work, peer and self-assessments, and case studies. Each CO is aligned with one or more POs through CO-PO mapping. The performance of students in these assessments is then used to calculate attainment levels for each CO, which in turn provide insights into attainment levels for POs. The final marks obtained by students in each course serve as indicators for calculating Course Outcomes.

CO Attainment:

Level-1:

Definition: At least 50% of students pass.

Interpretation: This level signifies the basic level of attainment, indicating that a significant portion of students perform above average, though there is room for improvement for the majority.

Action Steps: Additional support and resources may be directed towards students performing below average to enhance their performance.

Level-2:

Definition: At least 60% of students pass.

Interpretation: This level suggests progress towards improved performance, though the class has yet to achieve an ideal state where the majority exceed the average.

Action Steps: Investigation into teaching methods and curriculum design may be warranted to identify areas for improvement.

Level-3:

Definition: At least 70% of students score above the class average.

Interpretation: This target level of attainment indicates that a substantial portion of the class performs above average, suggesting that educational objectives are likely being met broadly.

Action Steps: It is advisable to maintain effective strategies while addressing the needs of students performing below average.

PO Attainment:

The Program Outcome (PO) Attainment formula calculates the average attainment level for each PO by considering the attainment levels of all courses mapped to that particular PO. Mathematically represented as:

$$\text{PO Attainment} = (\text{Number of courses mapped to PO}) / (\text{Sum of attainment levels mapped to a PO})$$
