# Kisan credit delayed: 54% farmers

45 farmers from each of the 11 taluks of Kalaburagi district were selected for the survey

A THESIS submitted by the research scholar Siddarth Nagamurthy Madankar on the 'Performance Evaluation of Kisan Credit Cards-A case Study of Kalaburagi district' which was awarded Ph D by Gulbarga University recently this year has stid that though most of the respondents were happy with the

Kisan Cards, 54 percent of the respondents have opined that the timely availability of credit from Kisan cards is boor and moderate.

The study for the subject was done by Siddartha Madankar under the guidance of research supervisor Prof A P Hosmani and Siddartha Madankar the Gulbarga Univer-

sity awarded Ph D to the thesis a few weeks back. The Kisan Credit Card (KCC) Scheme was introduced by the then Union Minister of Finance Yashwant Sinha in his budget speech in the Parliament in June 1998.

The main motto of KCC is to meet the comprehensive credit

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requirements of the agriculture sector by giving financial support to the farmers. Provision has been made under KCC for providing adequate and timely support from the banking system to the farmers for their cultivation needs including purchase of inputs in a flexible and cost effective manner is the main objective of Kisan Credit Card, said Siddartha Madankar, in his thesis.

> For the purpose of the study, primary data was collected through a survey of 495 respondents (who availed the benefit of KCC) in Kalaburagi district, a stratified random sampling technique has been chosen for the study. Research questionnaires and inter-

view schedules were used as the significant research tools to collect primary information from the selected research sample KCC holders. 45 farmers from each of the 11 taluks of Kalaburagi district were selected for the survey.

Kalaburagi district was purposely selected for the research

study due to varied climatic conditions and different crop growing farmers were available as well as having good performance in implementing KCC scheme. The study covers the years from 2015-16 to 2019-20. 76 percent of respondents were male and the remaining 24 percent were female. 207

farmers are in the age group of 41 to 50 years 186 farmers are in the age group of 50 to 68 years. 33 percent of the respondents studied the PUC which is followed by illiterate 29 percent. 75 percent of respondents were aware of the KCC scheme, 25 percent were found to have no idea regarding KCC.

The survey revealed that 265 (53.53 %) respondents felt that the KCC Scheme has fully satisfied them. It is found that 75 % respondents were having a negative approach towards the price for proper agriculture products. According to the survey, 227 farmers (46 %) have felt that it would not be possible to repay loans because of the inadequacy of their income.

36 % of the respondents feel that higher family consumption is the main reason for not repaying the loan regularly 46 percent of the respondents said the sufficient limit as per requirement is poor to need improvement and wanted the agency to increase the credit limit. It is also found in the survey that 80 percent of the respondents were unhappy with the problem regarding fixing the due date.
