Kisan credit delayed: 54% farmers

A THESIS submitted by the research scholar Siddharth Naga-murthy Madankar on the 'Per-formance Evaluation of Kisan Credit Cards-A case Study of Kalaburagi district' which was awarded Ph D by Gulbarga Uni-versity recently this year has said that though most of the re-spondents were happy with the Kisan Cards, 54 percent of the respondents have opined that the timely availability of credit from Kisan cards is poor and moderate.

The study for the subject was done by Siddhartha Madankar under the guidance of research supervisor Prof A P Hosmani and the Gulbarga Univer-sity awarded Ph D to the thesis a few weeks back. The Kisan Credit Card (KCC) Scheme was introduced by the then Union Minister of Finance Yashwant Sinha in his budget speech in the Parliament in June 1998.

The main motto of KCC is to meet the comprehensive credit

requirements of the agriculture sector by giving financial sup-port to the farmers. Provision has been made under KCC for providing adequate and timely support from the banking sys-tem to the farmers for their cul-tivation needs including pur-chase of inputs in a flexible and cost effective manner is the main objective of Kisan Credit Card, said Siddhartha Madankar, in his thesis.

For the purpose of the study, primary data was collected through a survey of 495 respond-ents (who availed the benefit of KCC) in Kalaburagi district, a stratified random sam-pling technique has been chosen for the study. Research ques-tionnaires and inter-view schedules were used as the significant research tools to collect primary information from the selected re-search sample KCC holders. 45 farmers from each of the 11 taluks of Kalaburagi district were selected for the survey.

Kalaburagi district was pur-posedly selected for the research

RECOMMENDATIONS MADE IN THE THESIS

- The banks should make easier the loan process easier because farmers are not fully aware about the KCC Scheme and policy norms in Kalaburagi district.

- To increase the time duration of term loan in KCC Scheme

- Government of India should monitor Kisan Credit Card Scheme time to time

- Non-registered farmers should also be considered under KCC Scheme and

- To adopt measures to reduce paper work under KCC Scheme

farmers are in the age group of 41 to 50 years 186 farmers are in the age group of 50 to 68 years. 33 percent of the respondents studied the PUC which is fol-lowed by illiterate 29 percent. 75 percent of respondents were aware of the KCC scheme. 25 percent were found to have no idea regarding KCC.

The survey revealed that 265 (53.53 %) respondents felt that the KCC Scheme has fully satis-fied them. It is found that 75 % respondents were having a neg-ative approach towards the price for proper agriculture products. According to the sur-vey, 227 farmers (46 %) have felt that it would not be possible to repay loans because of the in-adequacy of their income.

36 % of the respondents feel that higher family consumption is the main reason for not repay-ing the loan regularly 46 percent of the respondents said the suf-ficient limit as per requirement is poor to need improvement and wanted the agency to in-crease the credit limit. It is also found in the survey that 80 per-cent of the respondents were unhappy with the problem re-garding fixing the due date.

study due to varied climatic conditions and different crop growing farmers were avail-able as well as having good per-formance in implementing KCC scheme. The study covers the years from 2015-16 to 2019-20. 76 percent of respondents were male and the remaining 24 percent were female. 207
