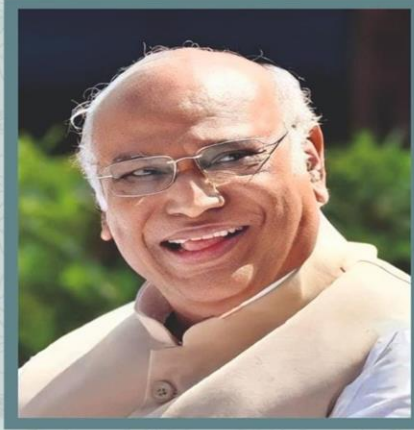

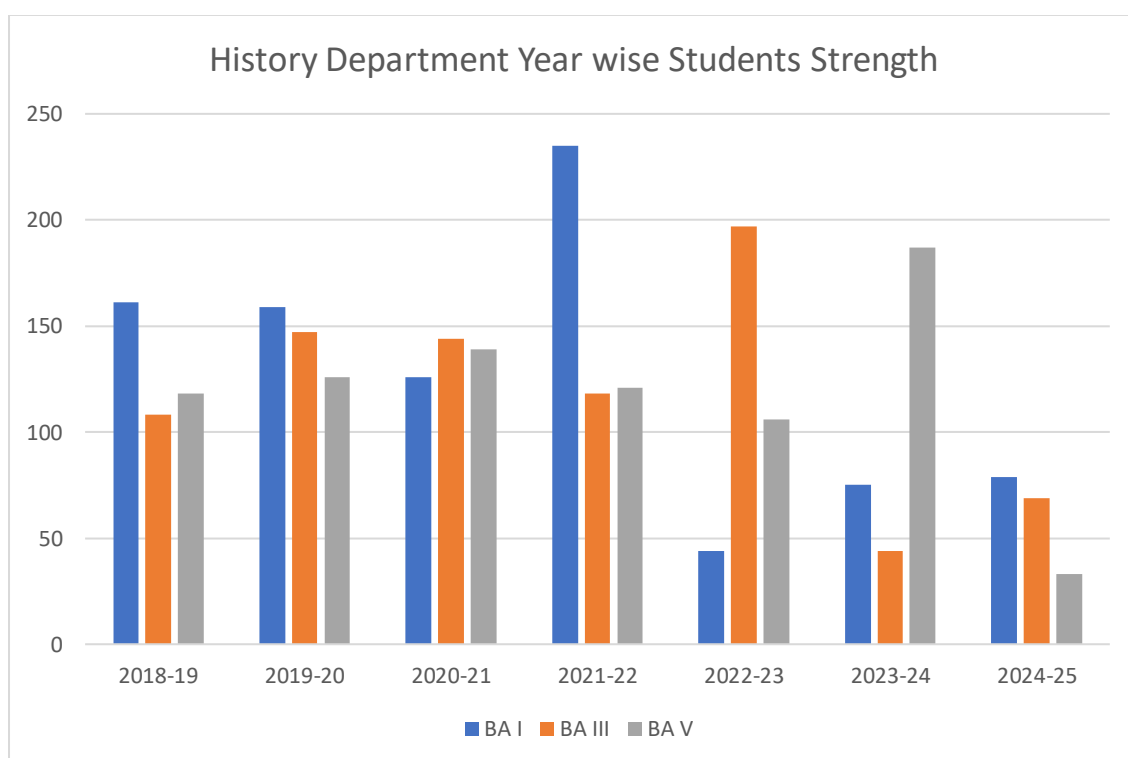


Chart showing Students strength from 2018-19 to 2024-25 academic year.

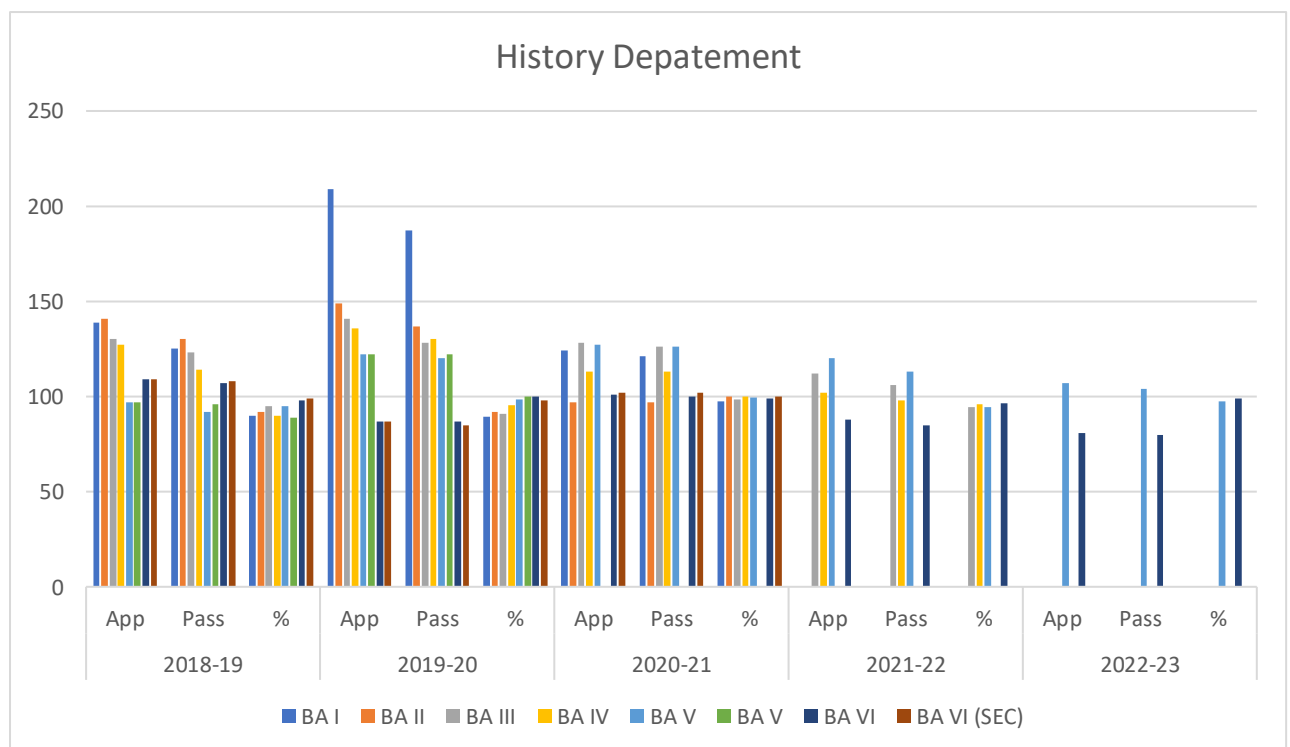


Chart showing Five-year students result analysis
